Each segment is 6 Disciplines. Two segments (12 Disciplines) is a 1 year degree program.



D. DISCIPLESHIP – INNER HEALING & EVANGELISM DISCIPLESHIP - INNER HEALING (D-1) DISCIPLESHIP - EVANGELISM (D-2)

D. DISCIPLESHIP- INNER HEALING (D-1)

These 6 courses/disciplines solidify the needed foundations for Inner Healing.

Experiencing God's Love-1 [EGL-1]: God's child will be required to participate in this prepared course either online or in class. You will participate as a "trainee" and be required to form a small group of three individuals minimum to multiply yourself. This is a course on healing and growing in Christ. [SEE www.altogetherlovely.org/resources to print the necessary books for your class]. 2 hrs / wk (24 wks) or 4 hrs / wk (12 wks) required.

Writing Prayer Journals-1 [WPJ-1]: The healing child of God is to write a personal prayer journal. In this journal you will share your love for God, your struggles, joys, vision, etc. This is very similar to prayer but journalizing helps put the words down on paper and allows for deeper healing in many cases. 16 to 24 weeks required.

Healing Prayer-1 [HP-1]: The healing child of God is to go to a trusted & discerning person (man to man – woman to woman) and have them pray for them. This course goes along nicely with the inner healing book. Be open to your partner praying with you in areas of repentance, inner healing, and forgiveness. Humility is a must here. 16 to 24 weeks required.

Christian Writing & Art-1 [CWA-1]: Using their God-given creativity and with the guidance of the Holy Spirit, the believer will be asked to write Christian stories &/or draw Christian art. These can be directed to adults, teenagers, children, etc. These stories and/or art must encourage, buildup, and challenge the Body of Christ. Scriptures can be used for the stories and/or the art. 16 to 24 weeks required.

Outreach Drama & Worship Guitar-1 [ODWG-1]: You will be asked to study the endless possibilities of sharing the Gospel worldwide through drama and/or worship guitar. You are to put together a drama and perform it either individually or in a group. And/or you will learn how to play a few simple songs on the guitar. Then lead a bible study or church group in worship. 16 to 24 weeks required.

Writing Biblical Poetry & Songs-1 [WBPS-1]: The saint will be required to write Christian Biblical Poetry and/or Songs. Different kinds of poetry writing will be taught and used to express the intimacy of Christ. And/or the saint can write Christian worship songs to use in building up the Body of Christ through the Power of the Holy Spirit. These may vary from intimate worship, children's worship, to lively worship. Then, in the Power of the Holy Spirit, you'll share these songs to the Body of Christ. 16 to 24 weeks required.

D. DISCIPLESHIP- EVANGELISM (D-2)

These 6 courses/disciplines deepen & solidify the foundations for Effective Evangelism & the Joy of Soul Winning.

Testimonies, Tracts, Witnessing-1 [3 Disciplines] [TTW-1]: The child of God will be asked to write their Testimony and Gospel Tracts. You will also be asked to share Jesus Christ with people using your Testimony, Gospel Tracts, and sharing your faith in Jesus Christ through the Power of God's Holy Spirit. 16 to 24 weeks required.

Experiencing God's Love-2 [EGL-2]: God's child will be required to participate in this prepared course either online or in class. You will participate as a "trainee" and be required to form a small group of three individuals minimum to multiply yourself. This is a Christian course on healing and growing in Christ. [SEE www.altogetherlovely.org/resources to print the extra books for your class]. 2 hrs / wk (24 wks) or 4 hrs / wk (12 wks) required

Spiritual Gifts-1 [SPG-1]: Every Christian has spiritual gifts. They've either discovered them or they are just discovering them. This course will aid the "holy ones" in discovering and moving in their spiritual gifts as shown throughout the Scriptures. You will also be required to seek out a "spiritual counselor" to guide you. 16 to 24 weeks required.

Writing Commentaries-1 [WC-1]: The "vessel of honor" will be instructed in how to write Bible commentaries for certain portions of Scripture. This will be done through prayer, meditation, resource material, and under the guidance of the Holy Spirit. 16 to 24 weeks required.

INSTRUCTIONS:

* Find a Scriptural story appealing to you.
* Ask God how you could write a story or draw a picture of the story.
* Feel free to write any story or draw any picture as long as it glorifies Jesus.
* The story/art is to be something that could be used by the Body of Christ.
* Your goal should be for the story/art to glorify God.
* Make daily notes of what you’ve written/drawn.
* Complete the WEEKLY LOG each week.
* 40 hours minimum is required [you may take 16 – 24 weeks].
* Set aside 15 minutes/weekday (24 weeks) or 25 minutes/weekday (16 weeks).

- Pray before you start.
- Be focused on “glorifying God” more than in writing/drawing.
- When you are finish, take some time to thank God for His power and revelation to write/draw stories & pictures that will lead people to Christ and glorify God.

DO A SEARCH: CHRISTIAN DRAMA OR CHRISTIAN WORSHIP GUITAR

REQUIREMENTS:

You will be asked to study/learn about the endless possibilities of sharing the Gospel worldwide through drama and/or worship guitar. You are to put together a drama and perform it either individually or in a group. And/or you will learn how to play a few simple songs on the guitar. Then lead a bible study or church group in worship using the songs. [You may do BOTH (drama/guitar) or ONE (drama or guitar).]

INSTRUCTIONS:

* You may do BOTH (drama/guitar) or ONE (drama or guitar). Decide what you want.
* Find or write a script for a drama you wish to perform. We suggest finding a Scriptural story appealing to you. Then ask God to help you put together a drama that will glorify God. This can be performed at a Bible study, church service, or on the street.
* Learn a few worship guitar songs to minister with. You may wish to also lead a Bible Study, Christian service, or street ministry in worship.
* Complete the WEEKLY LOG each week. 44 hours minimum is required.
* Set aside 20 minutes/weekday (24 weeks) or 30 minutes/weekday (24 weeks).

REQUIREMENTS:

The saint will be required to write Christian Biblical Poetry and/or Songs. Different kinds of poetry writing will be taught and used to express the intimacy of Christ. And/or the saint can write Christian worship songs to use in building up the Body of Christ through the Power of the Holy Spirit. These may vary from intimate worship, children's worship, to lively worship. Then, in the Power of the Holy Spirit, you'll share these songs to the Body of Christ (Bible Studies or Sunday School). [You may do Poetry or Songs or Both]

INSTRUCTIONS:

* You may do POETRY or SONGS or BOTH. God will lead you.
* Find a Scripture, Scriptural story, or description of God that appeals to you. Then ask God how you could write poetry or songs about it.
* We highly recommend the poems/songs be something that could be used by the Body of Christ. Most importantly, your goal should be that the poems/songs will glorify God.
* Complete the WEEKLY LOG each week. 44 hours minimum is required.
* Set aside 20 minutes/weekday (24 weeks) or 30 minutes/week (16 weeks).

GETTING THE MOST OUT OF THIS COURSE:

In order to get the most out of this course, we recommend the following:

- Pray before you start.
- Be focused on "glorifying God" more than in writing.
- When you are finish, take some time to thank God for His power and revelation to write poetry and songs about God.

Suggestions for Your Poetry

1) Haiku: A three line poem. The first line is 5 syllables, second line 7 syllables, and third line is five syllables. For example:

God is so special (5 syllables)
I love Him with all my heart (7 syllables)
He's my Salvation (5 syllables)

2) Write a three line poem in the following manner:

God (write a word)
I love Him so much (write a statement about the word)
He makes me feel alive (write how the word makes you feel)

3) Write a poem using rhyme schemes. Like this:

Jesus came to earth (a)
From above (b)
He filled my heart (c)
With eternal love (b)

[This poem's rhyme scheme is abcb because line 2 & 4 rhyme.
Other rhyme scheme examples are: aabb, abab, abcabc, etc.]

WRITING PRAYER JOURNALS 1 (WPJ-1)

TEXTBOOK/MATERIAL:

BIBLE [You can do this as part of the book called Experiencing God's Love 1]

REQUIREMENTS:

The healing child of God is to write a personal prayer journal. In this journal you will share your love for God, your struggles, joys, vision, etc. This is very similar to prayer but journalizing helps put the words down on paper and allows for deeper healing.

INSTRUCTIONS:

* Write a personal prayer journal. You will share your love for God, your struggles, joys, vision, heart, etc. Make sure no one else reads your prayer journal. Some people even throw them away each day. Other people look back at them to see their spiritual progress.
* This is very similar to prayer but journalizing helps put the words down on paper and allows for deeper healing.
* David often "WROTE" how he felt (read the Psalms). Even when he was angry, feeling overwhelmed, or disheartened. But he always ended up "praising God".
* 40 hours is the minimum requirement for this discipline.
* We recommend 20 minutes/weekday (24 weeks) or 30 minutes/weekday (16 weeks).
* This goes nicely with "Experiencing God's Love 1" where you do prayer journalizing.

- When you are finish, take some time to thank God for His power and revelation to write your prayers, feelings, and joys to God.

PRAYER JOURNALIZING

One of the best ways to heal is DAILY PRAYER JOURNALS. Daily prayer journals are writing your prayers instead of saying them. Why write? Writing gives less time for our minds to wander. Writing allows the Holy Spirit to minister to us in a deeper way. Writing puts our thoughts on paper and helps RELEASE them to God. Here's how:

i) Sit down with a pen, paper, and Bible. Start by saying this prayer EACH TIME:

Father, I come to You through the blood of Your Son, Jesus Christ.

I thank You that You died for me and that I am Your child.

Forgive me for (confess your sins).

Now, come and fill me with Your Holy Spirit.

Father, I pray that nothing would disturb this time I have with You.

Father, would You quiet all demonic activity here in the name of Jesus Christ.

Thank You Father.

Now give me the power to write what YOU put on my heart.

You are so gentle, loving, and want nothing but the best for me.

I love You, Father God.

In Jesus' Name I pray. Amen.

ii) Wait on God and allow Him to fill your heart with what to write.

iii) Allow God to bring up whatever HE wants. Remember, He is gentle, caring and wants to heal you slowly, gently, and completely. Be open and let HIM do the healing.

iv) When you sense God's leading, begin to write from your heart the best you can. It may be about your day, or about something from your past, or you may just find yourself writing. Just allow God to lead you. There is no RIGHT or WRONG way.

v) Don't overwrite. Do what you feel you can do. Get to know yourself.

vi) When you finish, put your paper in a safe place OR tear it up and throw it away. This is ONLY between YOU & GOD.

vii) Finally, do something "POSITIVE". Rejoice, sing a joyful song, go for a walk, phone a caring friend, minister to someone, etc.

* Then complete the WEEKLY LOG each week. 40 hours minimum is required.

* We recommend 15 minutes everyday (or 20 minutes every weekday) for 24 weeks

REQUIREMENTS:

Every Christian has spiritual gifts. They've either discovered them or they are just discovering them. This course will aid the "holy ones" in discovering and moving in their spiritual gifts as shown throughout the Scriptures. You will also be required to seek out a "spiritual counselor" to guide you.

INSTRUCTIONS:

* Pray for God to bring a trusted, discerning, loving person (man to man – woman to woman) into your life. Visit them on a weekly basis for 1 ½ hours a week for 16 weeks. Each week, go through the 20 different spiritual gifts at the end of this syllabus.
* Ideally this person should have the gift of Administration . Administration is a gift that provides insight into other people's spiritual gifting as well as natural talent, which allows for placing people who want to minister in a particular way together with those who need just this ministry. These are "well connected" advisors in the body. [The Septuagint uses this same word in Proverbs 24:6 & 11:14.]
* Before the meeting, prepare the Scriptures on each spiritual gift. Also, spend time reading commentaries on these scriptures. Then spend time "meditating and praying" on each spiritual gift. [1 hour/week for 16 weeks. This involves 16 hours]
* Complete the WEEKLY LOG each week. 40 hours is required.
* You should take 1 hour/week studying/praying/meditating on spiritual gifts (16 hours). Plus 1 ½ hours/week talking to a spiritual leader (24 hours). Total is 40 hours.

GETTING THE MOST OUT OF THIS COURSE:

In order to get the most out of this course, we recommend the following:

- Pray before you start your time together.
- Be willing to share whatever God leads you to.
- Be focused on "discovering your spiritual gifts" and become willing to use them.

Administration is a gift that provides insight into other people's spiritual gifting as well as natural talent, which allows for placing people who want to minister in a particular way together with those who need just this ministry. These are "well connected" advisors in the body. [The Septuagint uses this same word in Prov 24:6 & 11:14.]

Apostleship is the ability to communicate across cultural barriers and plant churches where there is no knowledge of the gospel. It is usually accompanied with a distinct calling and a miraculous lifestyle. In Greek (apostolos) "a sent one", or "a messenger", a *Missionary*.

Compassion transcends both natural human sympathy and normal Christian concern, enabling one to sense in others a wide range of emotions and then provide a supportive ministry of caring and intercessory prayer. Also called the gift of <i>Mercy</i> .
Discernment is the heightened ability to read or hear a teaching, to encounter a problem, or to consider a proposed course of action, and then determine whether the source behind the teaching, problem, or action is divine, merely human, or satanic. This will be a much needed gift near the End of the Age.
Evangelism is a special ability to lead unconverted persons to a saving knowledge of the Gospel of Jesus Christ. The person with this gift has the wisdom to know when, who, and how to call the rebellious into the Kingdom of God. Evangelists are the spiritual "obstetricians" in the church.
Exhortation is the gift of being able to encourage others by well timed and wise <i>counsel</i> . This gift builds the Body of Christ by helping new, young and adolescent disciples to turn from sin and believe in the power of the Holy Spirit. Also called the gift of <i>Counseling</i> , or the gift of <i>Encouragement</i> .
Faith as a gift is an extraordinary confidence in God that is unshakable by situations, pain, apparent failure, or ridicule. This gift strengthens the individual and other believers (by example) to endure persecution and wait upon the Lord.
Giving empowers one in a sensitive way to detect material or financial needs and meet those needs with Spirit inspired generosity. Recipients of help from Christians with this gift have a clear sense that God has provided, not man.
Healing is a "sign gift" which enables one to function as an instrument of God's healing grace in the lives of hurting people. The gifts of healings (double plural in the Greek text) include miraculous healing of the body, the mind, the emotions, and relationships.
Helps enables one to assist people in skilled ways that are supernaturally enhanced by the anointing of the Holy Spirit. The helped person has the impression that they have been touched by God. Those with this gift should be highly esteemed in the Body.
Knowledge is an ability to remember Scripture or have it supernatural quickened, or to know a fact or truth about a person or situation revealed directly by the Holy Spirit--sometimes termed a <i>word of knowledge</i> .
Leadership in the Greek is actually "he who provides leadership in <i>giving aid</i> ". These go first and lead by example, so that others are motivated to follow. Those with the gift of leadership are quick to identify problems and show by doing how to minister to those in need. [1Cor 11:1]
Miracles is another "sign gift" where the gifted person is able to cast out demons, show a supernatural sign to unbelievers, or perform a public healing--even in a hostile and unsupportive situation--all to the glory of God. Those with this gift will be humble, broken people, full of the fear of God.
Pastoring is the collective (plural in Greek) ministry of the Elders to "shepherd" an individual or community of Christian believers. This gift is a special passion and empowering to lead people into green pastures, steer others away from danger, fight off predators, and bind up wounds.
Prophecy is speaking what God wants said with clarity, creativity, and power. It is also called the gift of <i>Preaching</i> . The primary ministry in this gift is not prediction, but in confronting people with the truth about God and man--with conviction and repentance as the result.
Serving is a gift which expresses the love of Christ by taking care of lowly or time-consuming tasks to allow others to be more effective ministers. Similar to the gift of Helps, but here the work performed is menial rather than skilled. Those with this gift are the truest and highest leaders in the church, and ought to be recognized as such.
Teaching is the ability to <i>understand</i> and communicate the Christian faith so as to make the truth clear to others. The result of this gift is the equipping and maturing of others in the body of Christ so that they will grow in grace and be more effective disciples.
Tongues enable some Christians (1 Cor 12:30) to praise God either in another language not learned (Acts 2) or in ecstatic utterance which is not an earthly language (1 Cor 14). In either case, one's prayer is directed to God, not to other people (1 Cor 14:2).
Interpretation of Tongues is required if speaking in tongues is exercised publicly in a loud voice. This gift allows one to declare to others the intent or meaning of the public ecstatic utterance, so that the entire Body is built up.
Wisdom is special illumination that enables one in a specific instance to grasp divine insight regarding a fact, situation, or context. This gift is useful in directing the Body in <i>what to do next</i> ; in making God's will known.

REQUIREMENTS:

In this 3 Discipline Course, the child of God will be asked to be involved in 3 aspects of Evangelism.

1) You will be asked to write 3 different types of testimonies. A short version, a medium sized version, and a longer version. Then they will be asked to share these testimonies in real life situations.

2) You will be asked to write and prepare Gospel Tracts (your own personal tract with your testimony in it if you wish). Also one or two tracts offering hope to hurting and suffering people. Or tracts to give to people involved in cults. Then you will hand out these tracts to individuals.

3) You will be asked to witness to people about the love and grace of our Lord Jesus Christ. In the Power of the Holy Spirit, you will share your faith in Jesus Christ.

INSTRUCTIONS:

* Part ONE, sit down and prayerfully write your testimony. You should write a short, medium, and longer version. Each testimony should talk about what your life was like a) before Christ, b) now with Christ, and c) your future hopes with Christ (present and eternal). We would also encourage you to gently share Scripture. Each testimony should include a gentle manner in which you share the Gospel and how to become a Christian. This will involve 45 minutes a weekday over an 8 week period [30 hours total]
* Part TWO, prayerfully write some Gospel Tracts. One of these should include your personal testimony. Other tracts can include witnessing to cults, helping those struggling with fear, depression, or finances, etc. Make the tracts “full of grace” and presenting the Gospel message and encouragement. Make these tracts something that you are comfortable with. This will require 45 minutes a weekday over an 8 week period. [30 hours total] [Do Part 1 & Part 2 during the same 8 weeks]
* Part THREE, you will be required to share your testimony, give out Gospel tracts, and witness to people about the love of Jesus Christ. You’ll prayerfully do this once/day for 16 weeks. You will also be required to share your testimony at a Bible Study or Worship service to a larger group of people. This will require 45 minutes every day over a 16 week period. [60 hours total]
* Complete the WEEKLY LOG each week.
* This course will be over a 16 - 24 week period
* The minimum requirement is 120 hours for these 3 disciplines.
* Part 1 (8 weeks – 30 hours); Part 2 (8 weeks – 30 hours), Part 3 (16 weeks 60 hours)

GETTING THE MOST OUT OF THIS COURSE:

In order to get the most out of this course, we recommend the following:

- Pray before you start, make sure you have an attitude of prayer and that you are “filled with God’s Spirit” each time you write and share your testimony.
